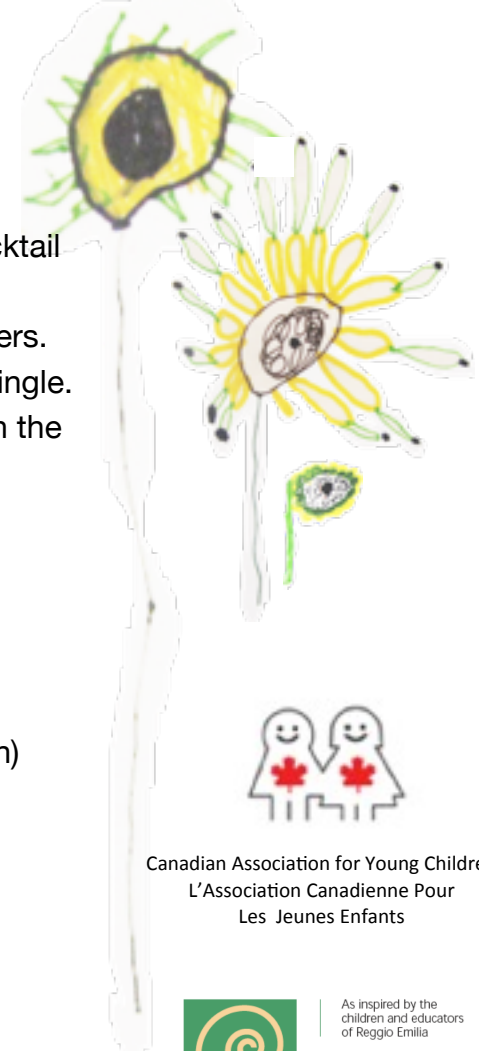
We invite educators from all grades to submit *proposals* for documentation posters.

- Summary of the project (including context, ages/grades involved, teacher reflection/interpretation)
- Relevance to other educators or the conference theme
- Photographs and other documentation of student work is not necessary in the proposal

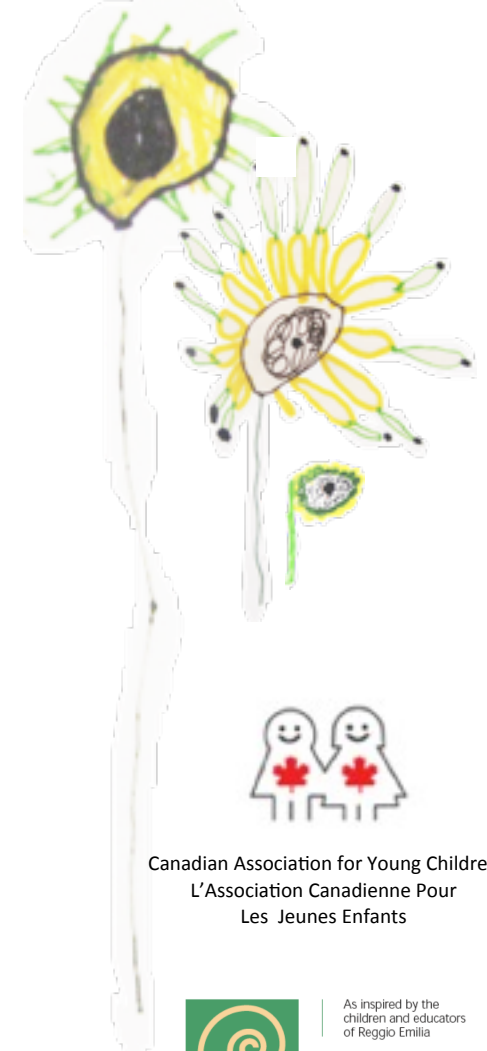
